





# Future4Citizens

19 October 2023, 09:00 – 17:30 CaixaForum Macaya, Barcelona

<u>Future4Citizens</u> (#F4C) is a European initiative to foster deliberation and democratic participation in Europe through a community-based approach. Rooted in Re-Imagine Europa's Narrative approach – *Listen, Reframe, Act* – the Future4Citizens project will host a series of Citizens Dialogues across Europe, to reimagine with local citizens alternative scenarios and solutions for our common future.

Globalisation and digitalisation have irreversibly changed our world. Inequality, social fragmentation and polarisation are widespread in our society, fed by anger and distrust towards all institutions. In a world that spirals out of control, we need to "*find a vaccine against anger*" (A. Damasio) and revert the cycle of distrust that dominates the social and political spheres. Yet, beneath these unconstructive and divisive emotions, there is a will to re-imagine: citizens urge for a better society in which voices are heard, and problems are answered with concrete actions. Engaging local communities in meaningful debates about their future is key to re-establishing trust and safeguarding those values and institutions most cherished by Europeans.

On 19th October 2023, Re-imagine Europa will launch the <u>Barcelona Citizens' Dialogues</u> hosting the first edition at CaixaForum Macaya, in cooperation with La Caixa Foundation and the Spanish Committee of the European League for Economic Cooperation, with the support of Barcelona City Hall and The Former Member Association of the European Parliament. The F4C Dialogue is under the framework of Barcelona - European Capital of Democracy 23/24 and the European Horizon Project ORBIS.

By facilitating listening and addressing problems at their roots, Future4Citizens celebrates diversity of voices going beyond traditional narratives and building together innovative solutions. We value the diversity of opinions as an enriching element of the deliberative process and bring people together to identify shared objectives. The uniqueness of this project is in uniting people behind positive visions and diagnosing potential for social actions. The final outcomes from different countries will be translated into policy proposals to help build the political agenda ahead of the 2024 European elections.
